Question Asked:

Apparently during the floods, or just prior to the floods, the Lower Murray Water advisory committee was not reimbursed for building the levee – so a bit of the conversation that we have just had – and protecting that precious infrastructure on the river. I am just wondering if you know anything about that. Is that something you can take on notice and share with us? Have you had conversations with them? Who has been responsible? They seem like they are wearing the burden and not being reimbursed for that.

Response:

Levees are largely controlled and funded by State Governments and Catchment Authorities. It is not an area that we can offer much comment on other than to recommend that there is more uniformity re levees on rivers.
