Flood inquiry to hear from water chiefs

A government department and water authorities are among the witnesses appearing at the next public hearing for the inquiry into the October 2022 flood event in Victoria.

Department of Energy, Environment and Climate Action Water & Catchments representatives will be followed by the Inspector-General for Emergency Management Victoria Tony Pearce.

In the afternoon the Committee will hear from North Central Catchment Management Authority and Goulburn Broken Catchment Management Authority.

Goulburn Murray Water is also scheduled to appear at the hearing.

"This should give us a better understanding of the decisions made in the lead up to, and at the time of the flood," Committee Chair Sonja Terpstra said.
