Select Committee on Victoria's Recreational Native Bird Hunting Arrangements.

Have your say on native bird hunting in Victoria

Public submissions have opened as part of the parliamentary inquiry into Victoria's recreational native bird hunting arrangements.

A select committee of nine members from the Legislative Council has been formed to conduct the review and report to parliament by 31 August 2023.

"This inquiry is looking at the operation of annual native bird hunting seasons here in Victoria, as well as arrangements in other Australian jurisdictions," Committee Chair Ryan Batchelor said.

"We'll also examine the environmental sustainability of the practice, it's impact on amenity and the social and economic consequences."

Relevant stakeholders are urged to make a public submission by 8 May 2023.
