These licences if leased out were \$1500/- per licence per month

The total income per month would have been \$1500/- x 14=\$21000/-.

Which would have been enough for rest of my life as superannuation.

I am 75 now & struggling to make ends meet.

My health has gone drastically down I had a heart attack & stents were put into me to survive.

If the govt. had paid market value I would not have worried about anything.

The VTD & TSC used to ask questions & had a price declaration form. So they new all the time the market value of the licences. By paying only \$125.000/- as compensation they have accepted that the licences had a value in the market but weren't prepared to pay according to valuation.

Hope all this explains my situation which the government has created by not paying the full compensation.
