When the new regulations came in, everything I worked hard for disappeared along with it.

I feel very angry, upset and stressed which has in turn affected my health. I am depressed and have lost my desire in enjoying the things I strived for. My income has been taken away and at my 76 years of age, I can't start all over. In turn this has placed a strain on my marriage and it has affected my wife's health. The strain put upon me and my family has been very difficult to cope with. I worked long hours and sacrificed so much to be in a better financial position but this is no longer the case.

I also enquired about the fairness fund and attended information seminars. I was so confused and was told that I was not going to see any benefit. I was so stressed at the time, I did not apply.

The devastation placed on me is unbearable. I can't sleep at nights. I constantly argue with my wife. I have to think twice about spending anything on my grandchildren and ourselves. That is totally unfair when all we have done is work to strive to be self-funded retirees.

I find it disgusting that the Andrews government has treated me and my family in this manner.
