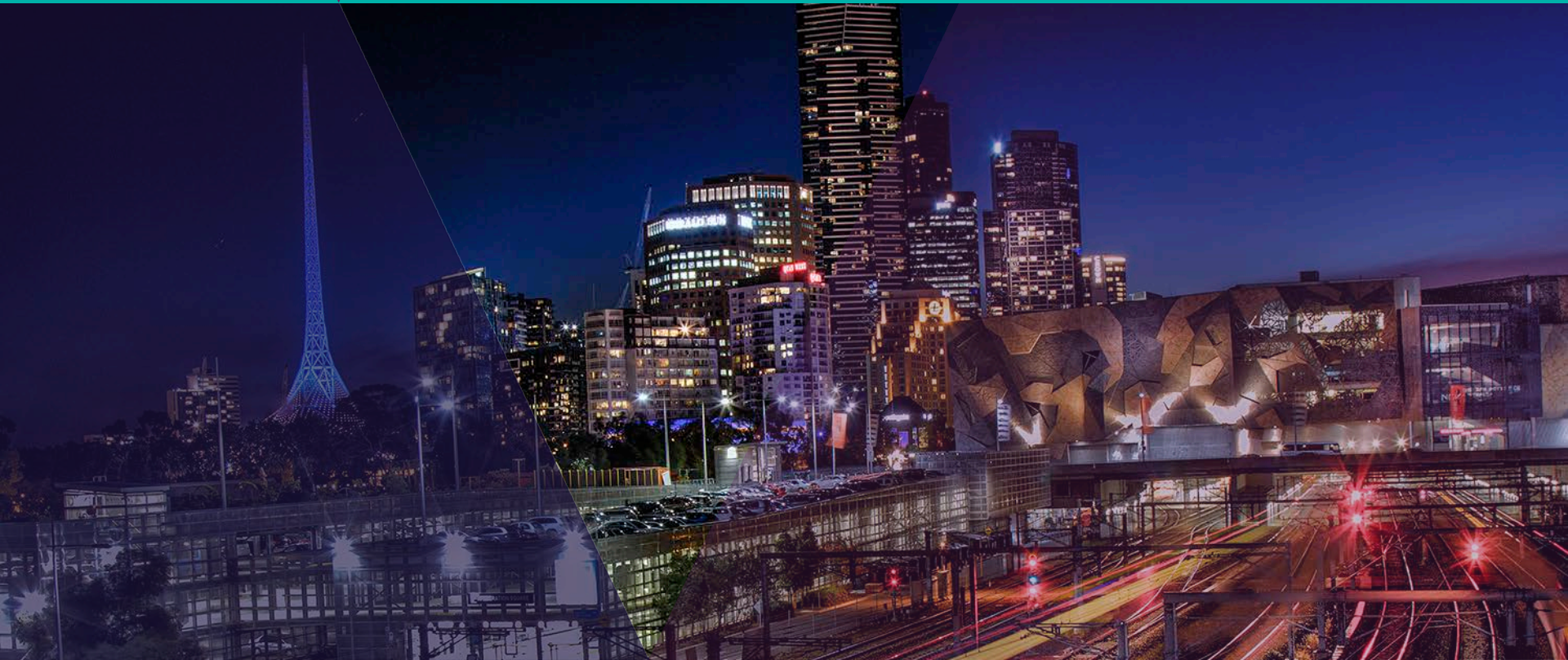


# 2019-20 State Budget

- \$165 million for the *Cladding Rectification Program*, to ensure government owned buildings are made safe.
- \$4.6 million for *Building Better Homes* to ensure new apartments are safe, liveable and designed to be integrated within local communities.
- \$20.5 million to the *Living Heritage Grants Program* for the conservation of State listed heritage places and objects across Victoria.
- \$2 million to help *fast-track construction and upgrade of non-government schools*.
- \$5 million to *support the planning system to manage and capitalise on Victoria's growth*.
