
## **Victorian rainfall**





## **2019-20 Budget initiatives**

#### 2019-20 Budget continues our investment in water

- \$5.1 million for the next steps in reimagining Melbourne's iconic waterways
- \$6 million further investment in smarter use of water in our cities and towns
- \$1 million to improve access to emergency water supply as part Drought Assistance package.



#### Casey Fields


- Recycled water is being used for irrigating ovals in sporting precinct – currently saves approx. 70ML of potable each year.
- This demand is predicted to increase to 108 ML per year as the site expands.
- Casey City Council aim to use the stormwater captured on-site to meet demand for total sportsground irrigation – aim to eliminate use of potable water supplies.
- The collaborative partners (South East Water and Casey Council) will also explore the use of Aquifer Storage and Recovery (ASR) as a strategic storage option for alternative water

#### Water investment


**\$718 million** has been invested over the last five years to protect Victoria's water supply and support a healthy environment, including an additional **\$12.1 million** in the 2019-20 Budget




### **Environmental contributions**

EC Tranche 4 collects \$537 million

The 2019-20 Budget allocates the remaining \$7.7 million from EC Tranche 4 meaning EC Tranche 4 is now fully allocated.
