\$5 million over one year for Crime
 Prevention Initiatives

 Budgeted output funding for Crime Prevention (including countering violent extremism) is \$18.2 million in 2019-20 **2019-20 PAEC Hearings: Crime Prevention**

Delivering on our commitments —Crime Prevention

- 2015 Review into the Community Crime Prevention Program
- \$19.4 million investment in 2016-17 including place based targeted grants and the Communities that Care program
- \$25.0 million investment in 2018-19
- More than 700 crime prevention projects funded since 2015

Delivering on our commitments — Crime Prevention





- 43 Youth Crime Prevention Grants
 projects totalling almost \$18 million 2,000 young people have participated in
 activities funded through these Grants
- 73 Public Safety Infrastructure Fund projects totalling almost \$12 million, including 250 CCTV cameras
- 460 Community Safety Fund projects totalling almost \$3 million
- 111 Graffiti Prevention Grants projects totalling more than \$2.2 million.

2019-20 Budget Initiatives

- \$5.0 million allocated to progress *Crime Prevention Initiatives* to focus on preventing crime from happening in the first place and helping people turn their lives around.
- This investment will support the government to develop a renewed crime prevention agenda by:
 - establishing a Crime Prevention Taskforce
 - building the evidence base and test new interventions
 - engaging with stakeholders and the Victorian community.
