### Making it easier for Victorians to get things done with government

#### **Key achievements**

- Last year, Service Victoria was the most downloaded app in Australia – it's now on more than 6.5 million devices
- Customers completed over 1.1 billion transactions with Service Victoria \*
- Customer satisfaction rating of 95 per cent
- More than 80 services available online so citizens can get things done with government departments and agencies at a time and place that suits them
- Victoria was the first jurisdiction to enable customers to add their COVID-19 vaccination certificate to a state app

#### **Key priorities 2022/23**

- \$99.8.M investment in Service Victoria to move even more services online, reducing paperwork for individuals and businesses, making it easier to get licences, permits and government payments.
- Victorians struggling with the cost of living will be able to use the new Savings Finder in the Service Victoria app to find government discounts, subsidies and other savings.
- More local council approvals and permits will also be added to the platform.
