#### Supporting our tourism and events industries through COVID-19

- There were two targeted tourism and events support packages in 2021-22
- \$200 million Business Stimulus Package
- \$20 million Victorian Events Support package:
  - Sustainable Event Business Program: Strategically significant events businesses.
  - Impacted Public Event Support Program: Tier 1 and 2 event organisers and suppliers.
  - Live Performance Support Program: Live music presenters and suppliers.
  - Independent Cinema Support Program: Independent cinema operators.

#### Supporting the long-term growth and competitiveness of our tourism sector

The Visitor Economy Recovery and Reform Plan is Government's whole of state strategy for the tourism industry. It is underpinned by a \$633 million investment.

- **\$283 million** Tourism Infrastructure Program, including:
  - Flagship Tourism Projects
  - Regional Tourism Investment Fund
  - Enabling Tourism Fund
- Marketing campaigns including 'Stay close, go further' and 'Visit Melbourne Get Set'
- Victorian Travel Voucher Scheme

Continuing Victoria's excellence in major events and sport

- Boosted the Major Events Fund to \$100 million per annum over four years
- National Business Events Program
- Victoria awarded the 2026 Commonwealth Games
- Victoria is hosting a safe return to major events across the state, including the Australian Open and the biggest ever Formula One Australian Grand Prix in April 2022.

Continuing Victoria's excellence in major events and sport cont'd.

- 140th edition of the Stawell Gift
- Work is progressing on major sporting facility redevelopments, including:
  - Marvel Stadium
  - Kardinia Park Stadium
  - State Basketball Centre
  - La Trobe University Sports Park as the 'Home of the Matildas'.

## This budget – key initiatives

The 2022-23 Budget is supporting the sports industry and major sporting events, investing:

- \$2.6 billion for the 2026 Commonwealth Games in Victoria
- \$24.8 million for Kardinia Park Stadium and State Sport Centres
- **\$1.7 million** to undertake site identification, design and planning for a new **Home of Victorian Motorsport**
- \$2 million to develop a business case for the future development of the Shane Warne Stand at the MCG

## This budget – key initiatives

The 2022-23 Budget is supporting tourism and major events, including:

- \$29.9 million for Regional Tourism Infrastructure Projects
- \$32.6 million for Melbourne Convention and Exhibition Trust
- \$8.3 million for Emerald Tourist Railway
- \$5 million for Visitor Economy Destination Marketing
- \$2.6 million to continue the National Business Event Program
