#### Victorian Racing Industry Fund – Infrastructure

Since 1 July 2021 the Government has provided more than **\$12.4 million** through the VRIF to support infrastructure projects, including:

- \$1.57 million to upgrade the inside grass track at Warrnambool Racecourse (Total Project Cost \$3.14 million)
- **\$1.05 million** to upgrade the synthetic track at the Pakenham Racecourse. (Total Project Cost \$3.5 million)
- More than \$850,000 to support the upgrade to Stainless Steel Raceday Kennels in Bendigo, Geelong, Horsham, Sale and Shepparton (Total Project Cost \$1.71 million)

## Victorian Racing Industry Fund – Raceday Attraction Program

- Crowds returned to the races at Warrnambool and Flemington in October 2021 as a part of the Vaccinated Economy trial.
- With crowds returning to racetracks, the Government has provided funding to support 94 events since July 2021, including:
  - Colac Gold Cup
  - Cobram Pacing Cup
  - Woolamai Cup Day
  - Seaside Festival at the Warrnambool Greyhounds
  - Stony Pony Kids Day Out
  - Bendigo Golden Mile Raceday
