This budget – key initiatives

\$17.2M in new initiatives to support ongoing growth in the resources sector

- Regulating Safeguards for Gas Resources Funding enables the delivery of critical gas regulation including Licensing, Assessments, Rehabilitation liability assessment, Compliance and Community Engagement to support new jobs and investment in Victoria
- **Developing Victoria's Critical Minerals** Development of Victoria's critical mineral opportunities supporting the transition to `net zero' emissions
- Mineral Resources Regulatory Reform Ongoing improvement and streamlining of sector regulation

...Bringing total Resources output funding in 2022-23 to \$69.4M

- Delivery of important projects e.g., extractives work program
- New geoscience information to attract investment
- Regulation of the resources sector to enable investment and generate jobs through the sustainable development of the State's earth resources
- Ongoing policy development and improvements to legislation & regulation

Key achievements

Better Approvals for Regulators (BAR) Program

• Earth Resources Regulation was one of the first state regulators to participate in the BAR program – with a focus on further improving the works approvals process for proponents

Orderly restart of Onshore Conventional Gas

- Commenced 1 July 2021 aligning with the Government's commitment to Climate Change action
- New Petroleum Regulations enacted in November 2021

North Central Goldfields Tender

- Successful North Central Goldfields Ground Release tenderers announced 29 October 2021
- Successful tenderers Fosterville Gold Mine Pty Ltd and Southern Star Exploration Pty Ltd are set to invest \$100 million in the search for gold

Rehabilitation / Innovation

- Improved regulation of site rehabilitation
- Quarry Transformation Grants

Stavely Ground Release

 Ground covering 11,000km² will soon be available for exploration which has potential to uncover copper, gold and other valuable metals, as well as mineral sands and gypsum.
