SUBURBAN REVITALISATION

Drive suburban activity centre renewal and address disadvantage



\$24.7 million for Our Suburbs: Living Local – supporting our suburbs to recover and thrive initiative.

This comprises:

- \$9.7 million to continue support for Suburban Revitalisation Boards
- \$15 million for the Living Local Fund for grants to upgrade community activity centres, with projects that promote social connections, enhance liveability and revitalise suburban shopping strips

Suburban Revitalisation Achievements:

Revitalisation Boards are delivering over 150 projects, including major streetscape improvements, public infrastructure, job pathways programs, events and community support programs in Boronia, Broadmeadows, Frankston, Lilydale, Melton, Noble Park, Reservoir and Tarneit.

Targeted revitalisation projects in **Altona** and **Springvale** are delivering major infrastructure to improve accessibility, community recreational facilities and provide local business opportunities.











Metropolitan Partnerships Achievements:

The Metropolitan Partnerships **ensure local voices continue to inform government decision-making** by bringing together 59 representatives, including experts and leaders from the community, to **identify and progress ideas and projects** that matter in their region of Melbourne.
