Key achievements over the last 12 months

Delivering on our 2018 election commitments

- Launch of Victoria's first ever long-term LGBTIQ+ strategy
 Pride in our future in February 2022
- Opening of the Victorian Pride Centre in July 2021, Australia's first purpose-built LGBTIQ+ community hub
- Delivery of the first Melbourne Pride streety party in February 2022, marking the 40-year anniversary of Parliament decriminalising homosexuality in Victoria
- Supporting 28 emerging LGBTIQ+ leaders to graduate from the 2021 LGBTIQ+ Leadership Program



Priorities for the year ahead

The 2022-23 Victorian Budget invests almost \$14.7 million to deliver *Pride in our future: Victoria's LGBTIQ*+ *Strategy 2022-23*

Funding will support the continued delivery of flagship Equality programs and specialised LGBTIQ+ services

New funding builds on \$6.5 million invested in 2021-22 to kickstart delivery of the LGBTIQ+ strategy

- > \$2 million to deliver state-wide training and resources
- > \$1.3 million to support the health and wellbeing of people with an intersex variation
- > \$2 million to support the government's Trans and Gender Diverse Peer Support Program
- > \$1.2 million to roll out awareness raising campaigns



Implementing Victoria's LGBTIQ+ strategy

Building safe, strong and sustainable communities

- > \$6.8 million to Melbourne Pride to run an annual state-wide event
- \$3.2 million to deliver a trial of safe spaces for LGBTIQ+ youth in Western Victoria
- > \$0.6 million to celebrate and support community-led events through the Pride Events and Festivals Fund

Creating equitable, inclusive and accessible services

- \$1.5 million funding under the Health portfolio to continue the Trans and Gender Diverse in Community Health Program
- \$1 million to build the capacity and skills of LGBTIQ+ leaders and organisations through the LGBTIQ+ Grants Program

Ensuring equal rights and freedoms

\$1.6 million under the Attorney-General's portfolio to deliver a specialised LGBTIQ+ legal service
