



 Phase 2 invests in improving compliance with the Road Safety Act for temporary traffic management



Delivering the Road Safety Action Plan

 \$263.1 million to continue the rollout of the Road Safety Action Plan

 Focus on priority cohorts with initiatives to reform Heavy Vehicle Licensing and additional funding for the School Crossing Supervisor program.

 Adds to existing investment including \$457.5 million for more than 200 safety upgrades in partnership with the Commonwealth Government and Transport Accident Commission.
