

2016-17 Budget Initiatives

Family Violence

•\$23.9m to strengthen the justice system's response to family violence:

- \$4.6m for legal assistance to VLA and CLCs to continue and expand delivery of specialist family violence services
- \$4m to begin delivering Royal Commission recommendations on court reform and to develop innovative justice approaches
- \$11.3m for perpetrator accountability
 - \$8.3m to DHHS to lead a review and expansion of Men's Behaviour Change Programs
 - \$3m to Corrections Victoria to improve information sharing across agencies to monitor and hold perpetrators to account.
- Additional \$4m in other portfolios within DJR



2016-17 Budget Initiatives

Court Safety and Security

•\$58.1m to implement a State-wide court safety and security model

Sustainable Transport of Deceased Persons Services

•\$9.9m over 3 years to fund new contracts with service providers

Sustainable and Modern Delivery Model for VCAT

•\$4m over 4 years for customer service enhancements

Integrated Case Management Capability

•\$1m in 2016-17 for planning for an Integrated Case Management Capability for Children's, Magistrates' and County Courts



2016-17 Budget Initiatives

More support for Aboriginal Victorians at risk of family violence

•\$4.2m over two years for specialist Koori family violence interventions and diversion.

Ice Action Plan Initiative

•\$32m over 4 years for Expansion of the Drug Court of Victoria, as part of the Ice Action Plan

JobWatch

•\$0.4m to JobWatch to continue providing free employment law advice
