

Solar Homes portfolio

The 2020-21 Budget invests \$191 million to build on the success of the Solar Homes program and increase our commitment to helping Victorians take back control of their energy bills.

- 42,000 additional solar panel rebates for households over the next two years, bringing the total over this time to 140,000 rebates;
- Expanding to 17,500 battery rebates over three years;
- 15,000 solar PV rebates for small businesses over three years;
- \$2 million additional funding for workforce skills and training






Solar Victoria was established to roll out the 10-year Solar Homes program, working with consumers, industry, regulators and training organisations to boost access to clean, affordable and reliable solar energy as part of Victoria's renewable energy future.

Solar Victoria is committed to:

- Ensuring the highest standards in safety and quality;
- Supporting industry to create new jobs and adding to the over half a million solar installations already on Victorian homes;
- Creating up to 50 jobs in the Latrobe Valley with its base moving to the new GovHub building in Morwell from early 2021.

Solar Homes and Victorians

Solar Homes is proving to be immensely popular with Victorians and the program is ahead of schedule

Solar Homes demographics:

- Two thirds of households report earning under \$100,000 per year
- 407 community housing properties supported to install solar PV systems
- 31 per cent of Solar Homes households are from regional Victoria

Solar Homes achievements:

- Over 122,000 rebates approved
- Almost 110,000 systems installed
- 646MW of solar PV capacity installed
- \$217 million in rebates paid
- Highest ever month for installations in November 2020
- Almost 900 installers participating in the program in 2020
