Supporting workplace safety

- As Victoria's OHS Regulator, WorkSafe is taking action to ensure employers are meeting their Occupational Health and Safety obligations
- ▼ WorkSafe has issued 12,888* improvements notices in 2019-2020
- ▼ 118* prosecutions completed
- As of midnight 30 November 2020, WorkSafe has undertaken 17,888 visits and enquires related to COVID-19, including 11,187 physical inspections where COVID-19 enquiries have been made.



Supporting injured workers

- 82,711* injured workers were supported with treatment and/or weekly benefits in the 2019-20 financial year
- In 2019-2020 WorkSafe received 30,038 new claims
- 12,990* injured workers were assisted back to work, with a focus on tailoring services to better meet the needs of injured workers
- WorkSafe achieved a strong client service result of 90.0%
- Established the Workers Compensation Independent Review Service

Delivering on our commitments

- Legislating workplace manslaughter laws in Victoria
- Recruiting more inspectors, including specialist construction inspectors
- Introducing legislation for provisional payments for mental injury WorkCover claims
- Progressing the Silica Action Plan



Driving reforms and raising awareness

- Launched comprehensive review into Dangerous Goods Act 1985 and associated regulations
- Establishing the legislated Workplace Incidents Consultative Committee
- ▼ Publishing key guidance for employers and businesses to support them in creating safe and healthy workplaces
- Ran awareness and education campaigns to drive public awareness of the importance of workplace safety
