

Government investments are targeted to help businesses and communities respond and recover to the pandemic

- Over 28,000 rural and regional businesses and community organisations were provided more than **\$586 million** in **COVID-19 related financial support**
- Rural and regional businesses have been supported through the \$1.7 billion
 Economic Survival Package
- **\$3 billion Business Resilience Package** in cash grants, tax relief and cashflow support will be delivered to businesses that have been most affected by restrictions
- **\$40 million Community Sport Sector COVID-19 Survival Package** to assist over 3,000 regional clubs, leagues and associations to come back 'ready to play'
- Sustained engagement with regional businesses and industry to understand impacts and tailor rescue packages and guidance on COVIDSafe practices
- On the ground assistance for border communities, helping to navigate issues arising from enforced state border closures

Delivering a whole of government approach to regional development

- Ongoing commitment to growing regional Victoria's economy through investing in jobs, community and people
- Whole of government policy and implementation coordinated through Rural and Regional Victoria Group
- Working closely within communities and with Regional Partnerships to identify challenges and solutions, so responses are locally-led and community-oriented
- Targeted additional support to regions that are experiencing complex challenges and economic transition
- Focus on building regional resilience and economic diversity

2020-21 Victorian Budget

Putting Regional People First: Delivering Investment to position Regional Victoria for a strong recovery

- Over **\$8 billion of investment** will help regional Victoria come back stronger
- \$6 billion to build more than 12,000 new social and affordable homes and make housing more affordable a quarter of the investment will be in regional areas
- \$4.7 billion investment in country road and rail upgrades
- \$869 million extension of mental health services
- \$682 million to drive cheaper, cleaner energy
- \$626 million to improve digital connectivity across the state
- \$465 million for the Victorian Tourism Recovery Package

2020-21 Victorian Budget

\$156 million to extend the Regional Jobs and Infrastructure Fund

- Additional funding will support the extension of the Regional Jobs and Infrastructure Fund to create and retain jobs and support regional recovery
- RJIF will be delivered through three streams which will leverage private investment and improve economic and social outcomes for more than 1.5 million Victorians
 - **\$110 million Economic and Community Development Stream** funding for priority economic and community development projects across regional Victoria
 - **\$36 million Regional Jobs Fund** funding support for high-potential businesses in growth sectors that are looking to develop and expand their operations
 - **\$10 million Accelerating Readiness Stream** support to accelerate projects, including development of business cases and strategic planning

2020-21 Victorian Budget

Regional Priorities including supporting the Rural and Regional Victoria Group

- \$124.5 million will support the department's Rural and Regional Victoria group to enable diverse, thriving and resilient regions, including continued funding for the Latrobe Valley Authority
- **\$10 million** for COVID-19 Short-term Regional Recovery in 2020-21 this is a flexible fund to support community-led recovery initiatives
- **\$5.9 million** to support Portland's economic diversification supporting the ongoing diversification of the local economy
- **\$4.2 million** to develop Regional Skills Demand Profiles providing comprehensive region by region analysis of industry needs and local skills

Regional Partnerships will continue to support community recovery

- Our close engagement with rural and regional industry and community through numerous roundtables and discussions has meant we have heard first-hand how country Victorians have been impacted due to last summer's bushfires and the COVID-19 global pandemic.
- Common themes across the state include:
 - a tourism industry downturn
 - challenges with digital connectivity
 - significant job losses
 - disproportionate impacts on women and young people
- Regional Partnerships will continue to provide a critical mechanism to identify local challenges and identify recovery opportunities and deliver these straight to Government
