Key budget initiatives

GROWING SUBURBS FUND

The 2020/21 Budget is supporting high growth councils deliver critical local infrastructure

- The Growing Suburbs fund will support
 Melbourne's interface and peri urban
 councils to delivery critical local
 infrastructure that supports local
 economic participation and recovery.
- Program is designed to respond quickly to pressures being experienced by these communities.
- Funding will provide increased capacity for councils to respond to changing community needs and demands.
- The Public Libraries Expansion Program supports public libraries in the critical role they play across all Victorian communities.
- Funding will deliver significant improvements in Victoria's public library infrastructure, services and programs.
- Lifts the Victorian Government investment in public libraries in 2020-21 to a record \$56.9 million.



\$75.2 million in 2020-21

Government is providing additional \$50.2 million to expand the Growing Suburb



\$13.35 million over two years

Includes \$10 million for the Living Libraries Infrastructure Program in 2020-21 to support capital projects across Victoria that deliver community benefits and create jobs in both the construction and operating phases.

The 2020/21 Budget recognises the vital roles of public libraries

Key budget initiatives

COMMUNITY INFRASTRUCTURE LOANS SCHEME

The 2020/21 Budget is supporting delivery of community infrastructure

- The Community Infrastructure Loans
 Scheme supports the delivery of
 community infrastructure by providing
 Victorian councils with access to lowinterest, subsidised loans.
- Additional \$100 million in low-interest, subsidised loans to be made available to councils to support vital community infrastructure projects across Victoria.



\$22.5 million over 15 years

- Funding will support a second round of the Community Infrastructure Loans Scheme.
- Will support recovery from COVID-19 through the accelerated delivery of capital works projects

WOMEN BUILDING SURVEYORS

The 2020/21 Budget is supporting women in new career opportunities.

- New initiative to give women the opportunity to undertake training to become building surveyors in local government.
- Will support women to commence a new career or transition their career to become a fully qualified municipal building surveyor.
- Will address a shortage of municipal building surveyors in Victoria.



\$6.3 million over two years

Program will support 40 councils with funding of \$75,000 per year over the life of the program.

Key budget initiatives

MUNICIPAL EMERGENCY RESOURCING PROGRAM

The 2020/21 Budget is supporting councils in emergency management responsibilities

- Councils play a critical role in
- emergency management, supporting their communities before, during and after emergency events.

Program provides financial support to assist councils to undertake their emergency management responsibilities.



Additional \$1.0 million in 2020-21 (total of \$5.6 million)

Program supports 64 rural, regional and outer metropolitan councils to plan, prepare and deliver activities that assist their communities in an emergency.

ROADSIDE WEEDS AND PESTS

The 2020/21 Budget is protecting Victoria's agricultural industry

- The Roadside Weeds and Pests
 Program will support eligible councils to undertake roadside weed and pest control work.
- Funding for the 56 regional, rural and interface councils with responsibility for maintaining rural local roads.

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\$2.79 million in 2020-21

- Funding is for control planning and activities to prevent the establishment and spread of weeds and pests.
- The funding will be provided to eligible councils through an allocation based on each eligible council's relative length of local roads.

Local Government 2020 achievements



COVID RESPONSE AND SUPPORT TO COUNCILS

The Victorian Government has **supported councils** by providing funding including

- a \$75.2 million extension for the Growing Suburb Fund
- \$208.9 million for the Working for Victoria program, which has generated 4,677 local government jobs in communities across Victoria
- 37 shovel-ready projects with a combined project value of \$277 million through the \$2.7 billion Building Works Package
- a \$29.5 million Outdoor Eating and Entertainment Package, and
- \$3.8 million for the Rural Councils
 Information Technology Support Program.

LGV is providing **proactive advice** and **assistance** to councils to support the vital work they are doing in their communities.



SAFE AND SECURE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ELECTIONS

These were the **largest government elections** in Victoria, with

- 298 separate elections for 76 of Victoria's 79 councils
- Over 4 million voters enrolled and 2,186 candidates participating to elect 622 councillors.
- The voter participation rate for the 2020 elections was 83.6 per cent, a significant increase on the 73.2 per cent participation rate in the 2016 elections.

Victoria is now leading the nation with the highest number of elected female councillors

- In 2020, 272 women were elected to council,
- In 2020, 854 women nominated for council across Victoria
- 1075 women undertook Local Government Candidate training in 2020.



LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 2020 IMPLEMENTATION

- The Local Government Act 2020 is the most ambitious reform to the local government sector in over 30 years.
- The new Act provides a contemporary and accessible legislative framework underpinned by a principle based framework.
- The new Act will improve local government democracy, accountability and service delivery for all Victorians.
