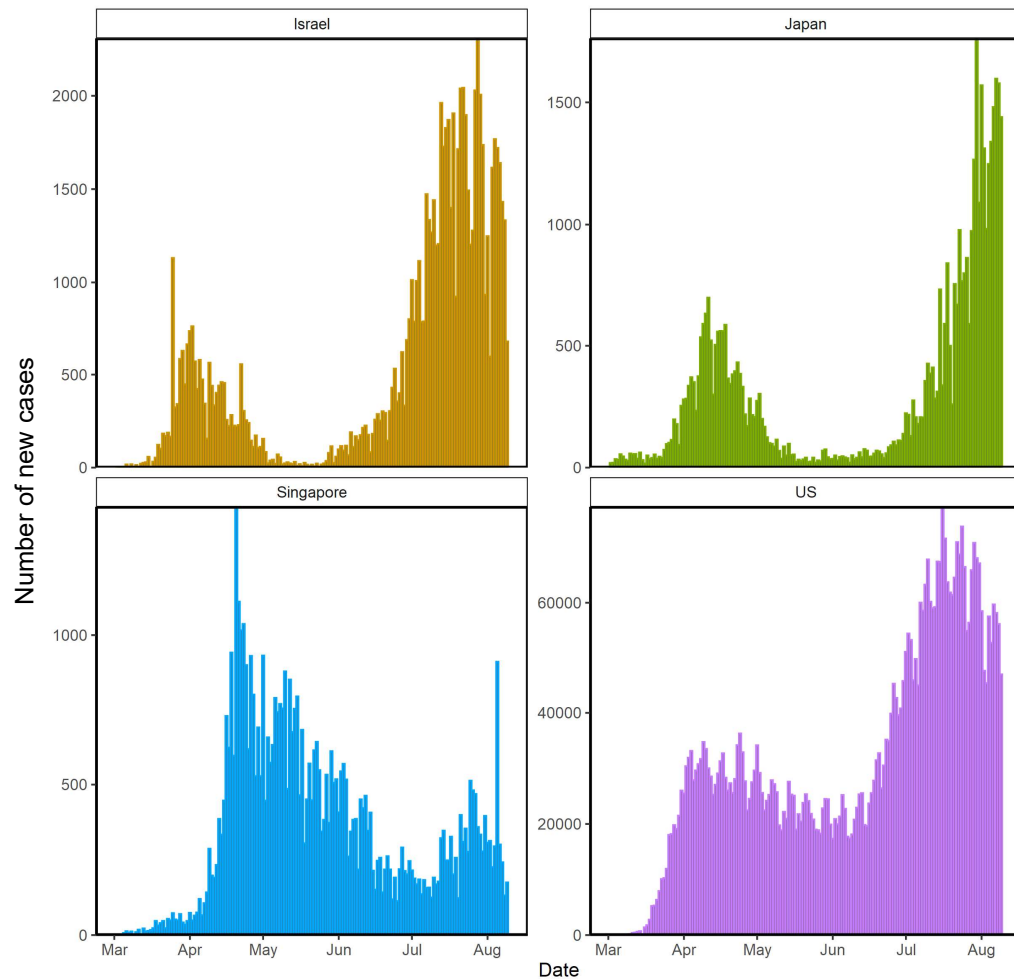

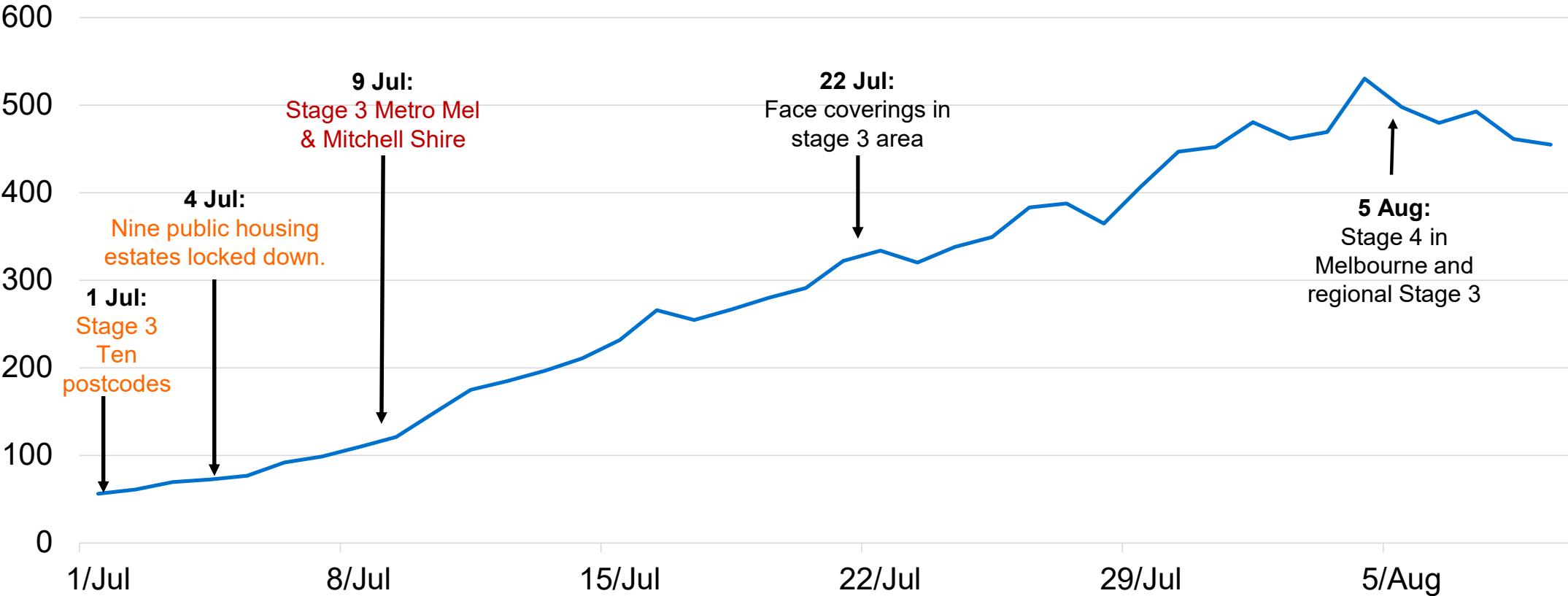
# Globally coronavirus cases continue to grow



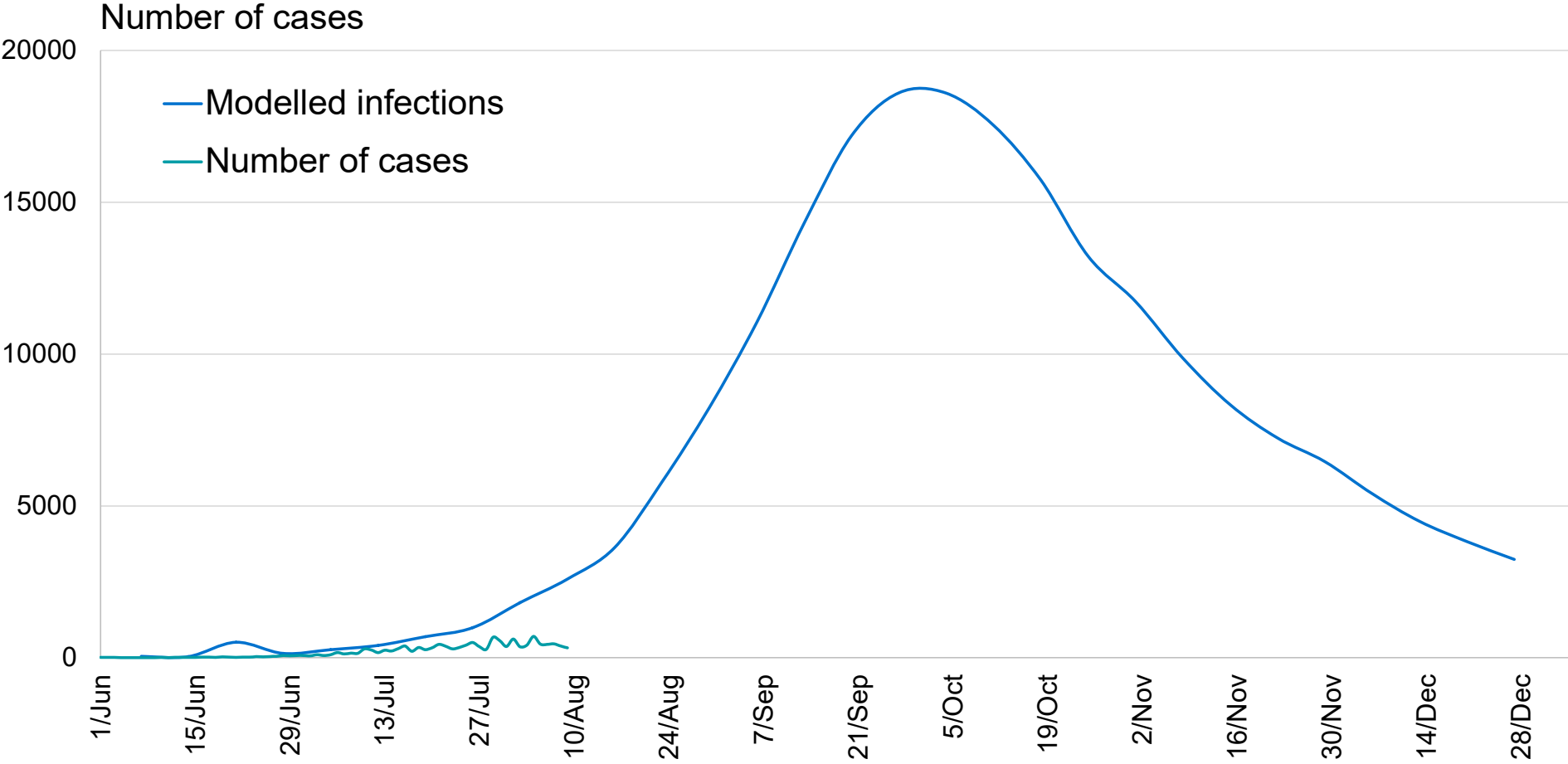
- To date nearly 20 million people have been diagnosed with coronavirus and 730,000 people have died.

Daily cases (7 – day rolling average)

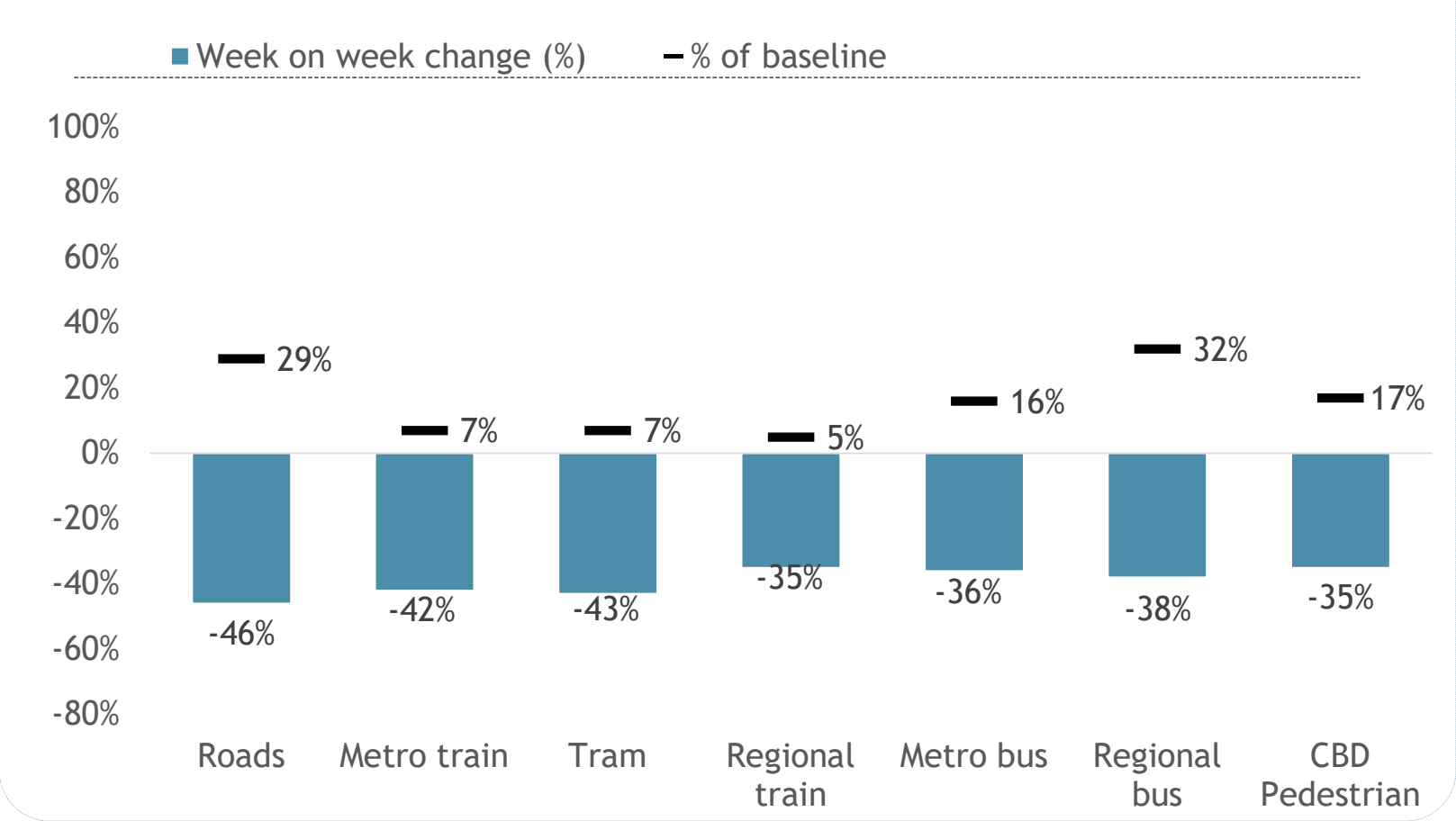


# Action in July avoided catastrophe

# Driving down cases through contact tracing

Case and contact tracing performance	Status to report
1. Proportion of outstanding case notifications (>24 hours since health department notified of positive result)	None (0%)
2. Proportion of outstanding case interviews (>24 hours since health department notified of a positive result)	10-25% of new cases are awaiting interview at 24hrs* <i>* Did not answer telephone and were not home ≤24hrs</i>
3. Proportion of known contacts awaiting notification (>48 hours since health department notified of a positive result)	Less than 1% of known contacts are awaiting notification

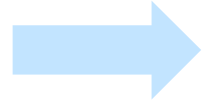

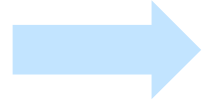
