NB: Audio video links include calls via Webex, Zoom and iMediation. In addition to matters heard at VCAT by audio video link, VCAT heard 2,832 in May and 3,914 in June remotely via telephone/teleconference.

Further I note that the Magistrates' Court heard, on average, 188 hearings via audio video link per day for May and June 2020.
