Key budget initiatives

METROPOLITAN PARTNERSHIPS

Ensure local voices continue to inform government decision-making



- > \$5.847 million over 2 years for Metropolitan Partnerships operation to bring together community, business and government leaders to drive placebased economic and social recovery
- Partnerships
 Development Fund of
 \$5.12 million over 2
 years for local onground projects that communities need, focusing on jobs, housing, transport, social isolation, environment and health and recovery.

SUBURBAN REVITALISATION

Drive suburban activity centre renewal and address disadvantage



- \$900,000 over 2 years for the Springvale Boulevard Project, a shopping strip renewal where we will partner with the City of Greater Dandenong, the local community and traders to revitalise Springvale's centre.
- The Suburban Revitalisation program recognises that local people know best what their communities need.

We will continue to work with the 8 Revitalisation Boards to deliver projects to reinvigorate their local activity centres.

2020-21 Achievements for Suburban Development

- Worked with communities on regional priorities for economic and social recovery.
- Partnership advice and efforts are leading to tangible outcomes in government decisions and the budget.

- Let's Stay Connected Fund supporting organisations to tackle social isolation.
- Projects like the Heart Foundation
 Podcast connect and support young
 people living with heart conditions.
- Museum in my Neighbourhood collected neighbourhood stories of adaptation and resilience.





2020-21 Achievements for Suburban Development

- Frankston and Broadmeadows
 Revitalisation Boards are delivering 19 projects, from new pathways, to upgraded facilities.
- New revitalisation Boards at Lilydale, Boronia, Noble Park, Reservoir, Tarneit and Melton are delivering 57 projects, including major streetscape improvements and public infrastructure.
- Neighbourhood Activity Centre
 Renewal Fund provided 32 grants for
 projects across metropolitan Melbourne
 for streetscape upgrades such as
 paving, seating, crossing and planting.
- 20-minute neighbourhood pilots (Sunshine West, Strathmore and Croydon South) are well underway, supporting local businesses and community.
