Mr HIBBINS: Thanks, Chair. Thank you, Minister and the team, for appearing this afternoon. Does the suburban development portfolio have any role in supporting Brimbank council to realise their Sunshine Priority Precinct: Vision 2050? I ask because Brimbank council and the community have gone to a lot of work in developing that vision and they feel that the airport rail proposal as it stands simply does not meet that vision and in fact does not realise the vision that the community has put forward.

Mr LEANE: I think, Mr Hibbins, as far as the metropolitan partnership, as far as whatever influence or advice that they have had on that particular project, I would have to take that on notice because I am not aware.

Answer:

The Suburban Development portfolio supports the Western Metropolitan Partnership to engage with local governments and communities on key priorities in the region.

Brimbank City Council is represented on the Partnership through the council's CEO. While the Partnership has highlighted priorities for integrated transport, the responsibility for Melbourne Airport Rail resides with the Minister for Transport Infrastructure.

The Victorian Government, through the Department of Transport, continues to work with key stakeholders on major transport infrastructure projects, including Melbourne Airport Rail and the planning and development of the Sunshine Transport Precinct.
