



Extractives

- The extractives sector is playing a key role in the state's **post-COVID economic recovery** effort
 - Rock, sand and gravel are **essential inputs** to the building and construction sector
 - \$40.4 billion worth of construction occurred in 2019-20 using a record level of extractive resources
- Extractive Industry Priority Projects List: 12 expedited quarry expansions will bring more than 90 million tonnes of resources to market
- Strategic Extractive Resource Areas (SERA) pilot projects aim to safeguard resources for our future needs in key supply areas.

COVID-19 pandemic

IMPACT

- All mining operations across regional Victoria and metropolitan Melbourne were able to continue operating under COVIDSafe Plans.
- Challenges to mining operations included logistical disruptions, restrictions on equipment and labour availability due to border closures, and challenges to sourcing new capital.

RESPONSE

- Deferred collection of rent and annual fees to aid immediate collection around \$3.5 million deferred by 6 months.
- Proactively engaged with industry to enable them to continue to operate in a COVID safe manner.
- Resources sector specialist workers whose skills couldn't be readily sourced in Victoria were eligible to apply for a Specified Worker Permit to enter Victoria.

2021/22 Budget: Securing the resources for Victoria's economic recovery

Support for ongoing growth in the resources sector - \$35.7M

- Enable delivery of critical services to support the sector's record-breaking activity, creating jobs, economic development and new resources opportunities.
- Reducing the risk of unsafe or harmful resource exploration and extraction activity in a growing and diverse sector.
- Maintaining and growing industry and community confidence through the ongoing delivery of efficient and effective policy and regulation

- Develop policy and legislative reform and implement programs
- Regulation of the resources sector to enable investment and generate jobs through the sustainable development of the State's earth resources

Consultation with industry, community and government agencies has underscored the need to modernise earth resources approvals and inform reforms.

A better approach to approvals will give industry and community greater certainty
