We have finalised some discussions internally regarding the setting up of the Project Reference Group (PRG) this week.

We are required to present a report to Council to have this formally endorsed, and this will be happening on 5 June – the next available meeting.

Further to the discussions we had on site, the timeline looks like this for the next month.

23 May	State Government Budget Announcement	This will confirm the scope of works being funded
Late May	Provision of concept designs from Sport & Recreation Victoria	
Late May	Update to user groups	
5 June	Formal endorsement of the Project Reference Group	
Early June	Nomination of representative from groups represented on the PRG	
Early June	First Project Reference Group meeting	

Following the endorsement of the PRG at Council, the nomination for representatives will need to be formally provided by each user group. To speed up this process, we ask that you have discussions about this with the Falcons Committee prior to 5 June, so that when you are contacted by Council to provide the nomination, this can be a quick process to set up, and we can have the first PRG meeting as soon as possible.

While there is some waiting at the moment, from June, things will be moving pretty quickly so we can work to the timetable dictated by the date of the Commonwealth Games.
