Minor party representatives to appear before election review

The Electoral Matters Committee will hear from representatives of the Angry Victorians Party in a hearing to be held on Monday.

The Committee is reviewing the conduct of the 2022 state election.

Angry Victorians President, Christopher Burson and Public Relations and Strategy Manager, Heston Russell will share their experience with the Committee in a hearing from 2 pm on Monday October 30.

The inquiry is examining a host of key issues from enrolment, to candidature, campaigning behaviour and the voting process, as well as the role and functions of the VEC.
