Peak bodies at hearing on rate capping

On Tuesday 18 October, the Municipal Association of Victoria and the Victorian Local Governance Association will be among several organisations presenting their views to the next public hearing on the Victorian Government's rate capping policy.

The public hearing by the Environment and Planning Committee will be held from 12 noon in the Legislative Council Committee Room at Parliament House.

It will include an opportunity at 4:15 pm for any members of the community attending the hearing to make statements to the Committee.

The inquiry is examining the outcome of the Victorian Government's rate capping policy on councils' viability, service impacts on local communities and impacts on the provision of local infrastructure.
