Next hearing on fire season inquiry

The Victorian Parliament's Environment and Planning Committee will hold the next public hearing on its inquiry into fire season preparedness tonight, Wednesday 17 August.

The public hearing will be at 7:15 pm in the Legislative Council Committee Room at Parliament House.

Presenting his views to the Committee will be Mr Michael Tudball, a CFA volunteer and firefighter for over 36 years and a member of the CFA Board from 2003 to 2016.

The inquiry is examining the preparation and planning that is undertaken for fire seasons.

It is focusing on the work of the Department of Environment, Land, Water and Planning, and its agencies, including Parks Victoria.

Issues being considered include the planning, implementation and impacts of preventative burning.
