Next hearing for fire season inquiry

The Environment and Planning Committee is holding a public hearing this Tuesday 28 February for its ongoing inquiry into fire season preparedness.

The public hearing will be held from 9:30 am to 3:30 pm in the Legislative Council Committee Room at Parliament House.

It will consider a number of issues including the relocation of the Skycrane from Ballarat to Moorabbin Airport, the payment of legal fees by the CFA and planning issues raised by the Nillumbik Pro-Active Landowners group in its submission.

The inquiry is examining the preparation and planning that is undertaken for fire seasons.
