Hearings next week on electronic voting

The Victorian Parliament's Electoral Matters Committee will hold public hearings next week on its inquiry into electronic voting.

Among those presenting evidence to the Committee will be electoral commissions, technology specialists and community advocacy groups.

Under the inquiry's terms of reference, the Committee is investigating the forms of electronic voting currently utilised in Victoria and other jurisdictions and their effectiveness. The Committee is also examining alternatives that are available that if implemented would ensure the continued integrity and security of the electronic voting system.
