A diverse range of organisations will present evidence to the parliamentary inquiry into drug law reform at a public hearing this Monday 18 September.

The public hearing will be at 55 St Andrews Place, East Melbourne from 10:00 am to 2:45 pm.

The Victorian Multicultural Commission and the Adult Parole Board of Victoria will be among those presenting to the Law Reform, Road and Community Safety Committee.

The National Drug and Alcohol Research Centre, and Families and Friends for Drug Law Reform will share their views with the Committee on how to minimise drug-related harms in the community.
