Drug law reform hearing on Monday

This Monday 5 June, the Victorian Parliament's Law Reform, Road and Community Safety Committee will hold the next public hearing for its inquiry into drug law reform.

The public hearing will be from 9:45 am to 3:45 pm at 55 St Andrews Place, East Melbourne.

Among those presenting to the Committee will be a drug court magistrate, community health service, rehabilitation centre and residents' associations.

The Committee is examining how effectively laws, procedures and regulations minimise drug-related harms.

As part of the inquiry, the Committee will consider approaches to drug law reform in other Australian states and territories and overseas jurisdictions.

It will also look at how other positive reforms could be adopted into Victorian law.
