# **Government agencies to appear at environmental infrastructure inquiry**

Several government agencies are set to appear at a parliamentary inquiry into environmental infrastructure for growing populations tomorrow (Tuesday 27 April).

The Legislative Assembly's Environment and Planning Committee has been investigating community access to parks and open space as well as sporting fields, forest and bushland, wildlife corridors and waterways.

The Department of Environment, Land, Water and Planning is expected to give evidence along with related agencies Vic Catchments, Victorian Planning Authority, Infrastructure Victoria and Office of the Victorian Government Architect.

The hearing, which commences at 10 am, will be [live broadcast](#) and the full schedule is available from the Committee's [website](#).

The Committee received 262 submissions and has already heard evidence from metropolitan, outer suburban and regional councils in significant growth corridors and peak academic, leisure and recreation stakeholders.

It is due to hand down a final report by the end of June.
