Hearings next week on state budget outcomes

The financial and performance outcomes of the 2019-20 Victorian state budget will be considered during a series of public hearings from 22 to 25 February 2021.

The Public Accounts and Estimates Committee will question a range of Victorian Government departments at the hearings, which will be broadcast live on the Victorian Parliament's [website](#).

“These hearings are an important part of Victoria’s regular cycle of accountability that begins with a review of the budget estimates and concludes with an examination of the state’s actual financial and performance outcomes,” Committee Chair Lizzie Blandthorn said.

The Department of Treasury and Finance will be the first to be questioned by the Committee from 9:30 am to 12:30 pm on Monday 22 February. The schedule for the hearings is available via [this link](#).

“The live broadcast of these hearings enables people across our state to watch a range of government departments explain what outcomes have been achieved for Victorian communities,” Ms Blandthorn said.
