# **Hearing to examine expansion of free tram zone and related issues**

On Tuesday 30 June 2020, the Legislative Council Economy and Infrastructure Committee will hold a further public hearing for its inquiry into expanding Melbourne’s free tram zone.

Being conducted online from 10:00 am to 1:00 pm, the public hearing will be broadcast live on the Victorian Parliament’s [website](#).

Presenting to the Committee will be representatives from the City of Melbourne, the Committee for Melbourne, Infrastructure Victoria, the Institute for Sensible Transport and transportation consultants MRCagney. The schedule for the hearing is available from the Committee’s [website](#).

The Committee has received more than [400 submissions](#) to the inquiry.

As well as examining the expansion of Melbourne’s free tram zone, the Committee is also looking into free public transport for all full-time students and Seniors Card holders, new technologies that enable intelligent transport systems that improve the performance of the network, and the effects and benefits of dynamic public transport pricing.
