First public hearing on gender responsive budgeting

On Tuesday 10 December 2019, the Public Accounts and Estimates Committee will hold the first public hearing for its inquiry into gender responsive budgeting.

The Committee will be questioning a number of government departments including: Premier and Cabinet; Health and Human Services; Treasury and Finance; Jobs, Precincts and Regions; and the State Revenue Office.

The public hearing will be held from 9:30 am to 2:40 pm at 55 St Andrews Place, East Melbourne.

The Committee's inquiry is examining the way the state government budget addresses gender equality.
