• if you like voting




• if you need support to vote

or



• only some questions.

You can do the survey

• on a tablet or computer



• on paper by printing it out.


1 You can do the survey on a tablet or computer




We have sent you the link to the survey.

You **must** save the survey on your tablet or computer when you have finished.




If you choose to do the survey it **must** be emailed to us by 18 December 2023.

You can press the link to download the survey.




When you open the survey you will be able to print it.
